Special Development Support Criteria

All requests must be received by APE not later than 30 November.

1. All requests must be received by IHQ not later than 31 December. Under no circumstances will requests received after this date be considered.

2. Following ICM approval of requests, funds will be paid 1/3 upon approval, 1/3 after the first six months and upon receipt of an interim report, 1/3 at the end of the year and after receipt of final report.

Special requests for variation in funding advances may be considered by IEO's, depending upon exceptional circumstances.

3. Request and completion reports must contain:

a) Definition of the special or unique aspects of the proposals and expected outcomes.

b) Complete description of proposed use of funds

c) Details on expenditures such as travel costs, promotional materials, etc.

d) Estimates on benefits anticipated must be included (i.e. number of new members, number of new clubs).

4. Projects must be of a special nature (not normal programmes) that are designated to expand and improve Y's Men International in the following areas: a) Membership expansion, b) Club extension, c) Leadership training, d) Any other project approved by International Council
